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A Critical Care Pharmacist is like a safety net for the ICU team, making sure that the sickest patients get the safest and most effective use of medicines.

Instead of focusing on one type of patient, they work across the whole intensive care unit—checking every prescription, fine-tuning drug doses, and spotting risks before they become problems. They're the medicine experts at the bedside, helping doctors and nurses choose the right treatment in high-pressure situations.

They also play a big role behind the scenes—reviewing evidence, developing guidelines, and keeping the ICU up to date with best practice. Critical care pharmacists need razor-sharp clinical knowledge, but also the ability to stay calm under pressure, communicate clearly, and work as part of a tight, multidisciplinary team.
